"Boligsosialt"?

Relates to housing and social services for the financially disadvantaged

- Physical housing
 - Rented
 - Owned
- Financial assistance to secure a home
- How to manage a home
- To some extent: Services in the home

Formerly state sponsored

Husbanken, the state agency used to finance the program.

As of 2017, the government decided to drop Husbanken's budget in this area.

The City of Oslo found money to go on with the programme in 2017.
